Built in 1924, the completely renovated two-bedroom vintage farmhouse boasts beautiful wood floors; cozy wood burning stove; a lovely open kitchen with new crisp white cabinetry and butcher block countertops; and a large, sunny primary bedroom on the second floor with skylights and ample storage. System updates include-new windows, hardboard siding with foam insulation, new electrical, radiant floor heating, and a Nortiz instant boiler.






